This technical rider is an integral part of the contract.

All elements of this technical rider are entirely at the organizer's expense (unless otherwise specified).

Technical aspects may be adapted to suit the performance venue, subject to prior agreement with the stage manager. All information concerning the performance venue must be discussed with the stage manager prior to his arrival, in order to ensure optimum Please send us photos of the chosen venue beforehand.

Be sure to consult the latest version of the technical rider.

Durée du spectacle : 3h15

Capacity : 400 if small layout; 800 if comfort layout.

Open space and continuous circulation. If there is a large audience, it allows the outsiders to enjoy the show

Implantation :

Minimum surface 25 x 30 m (even and flat)

Ideal surface : 30 x 35 m (even and flat)

Minimum height : indoor 6 m for the central mast, 4 m outdoor

Weather conditions and indoor fallback:

Le Bal des Oiseaux is designed to be performed outdoors, but if the weather conditions are such that the wind exceeds 50km/h and/or if there is more than 3mm of rain during the show, the performance will be canceled in accordance with the terms of the contract.

An indoor set-up can be considered in advance if it has been validated by our stage manager and if the decision to move in is taken on D-2 at the latest.

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Schedule

Get in : D-2 - Evening (Arrival 2 trucks plus 2 trailers and 12 to 13 people - please provide secure parking)

Set up schedule: D-1

- **Set:** 2 shifts (from 9am to 1pm and 2pm to 6pm)
- **Lighting:** 2 shifts (from 2pm to 6pm and 7pm to 11pm)
- **Sound: 1 shift** (from 2pm to 6pm)

Needs (staffing requirements) :

2 Lighting technicians 8h shift
2 Stage technicians 8h shift
1 Sound technician 4h shift
1 Surveillance / security guard shift (10 p.m. to 9 a.m)

SCHEDULE : D-DAY

Sound checks must be scheduled on each performance day, and not before 11am on the days following a performance!

- **Sound:** 2 shifts : 1 lighting technician in the morning (from 9am to 1pm) + 2 technicians to load out after the show for 2 hours
- **Lighting:** 2 loads out (after the show for 2h)
- **Set:** 2 loads out (after the show for 2h)

Needs (staffing requirements) :

1 Sound Technician 6h shift
1 Sound Technician 2h shift
2 Stage Technician 2h shift
2 Lighting Technicians 2h shift
1 Surveillance / security guard shift (11pm to 10am)

DURING THE PERFORMANCE : (30 minutes before the beginning of the show)

1 french SSIAP 1 equivalent : someone trained and certified in Fire Safety and Personal Assistance Service (1 for each performance if more than 1 show)
2 people to manage the public

SCHEDULE : D+1

1 shift (from 10am to 1pm)

Needs:

4 Stage Assistant Managers 3h

TEAM DEPARTURE: 3PM

please provide lunch on site for 12 to 13 people after load out

Volunteering

We ask for 8 to 10 volunteers:

- 4 to 6 people in the "costumerie" during the performance (flexible time) + 4 people for a costume parade (30 min)
- Day-1 : meeting at 6 PM pour all the volunteers for briefing and rehearsal.
- D-Day : arrival 30 min before the show

Please offer these missions to people you trust, who are motivated, somewhat inhibited and resourceful, so that they can enjoy them to the fullest.

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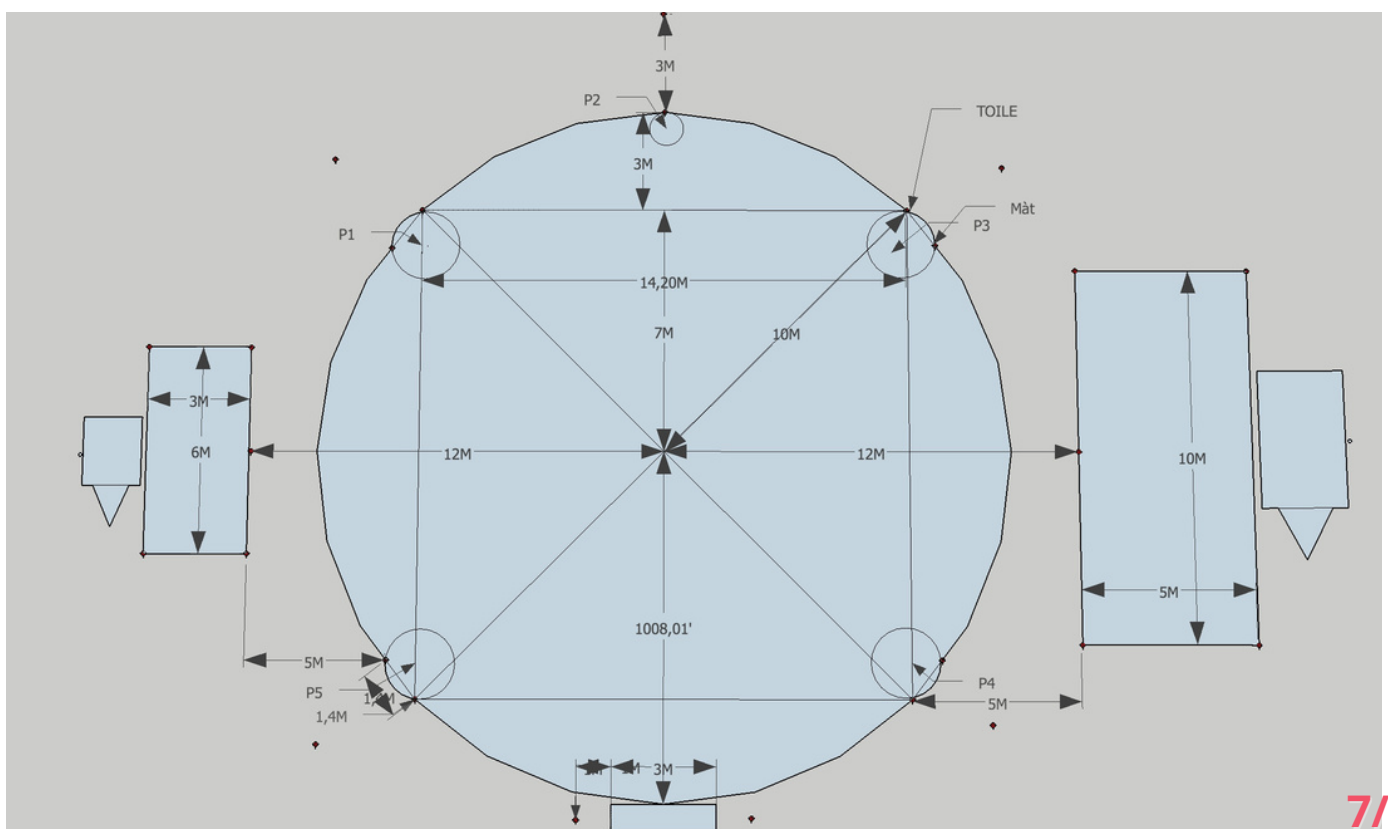

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Set-up area 30m X 35m

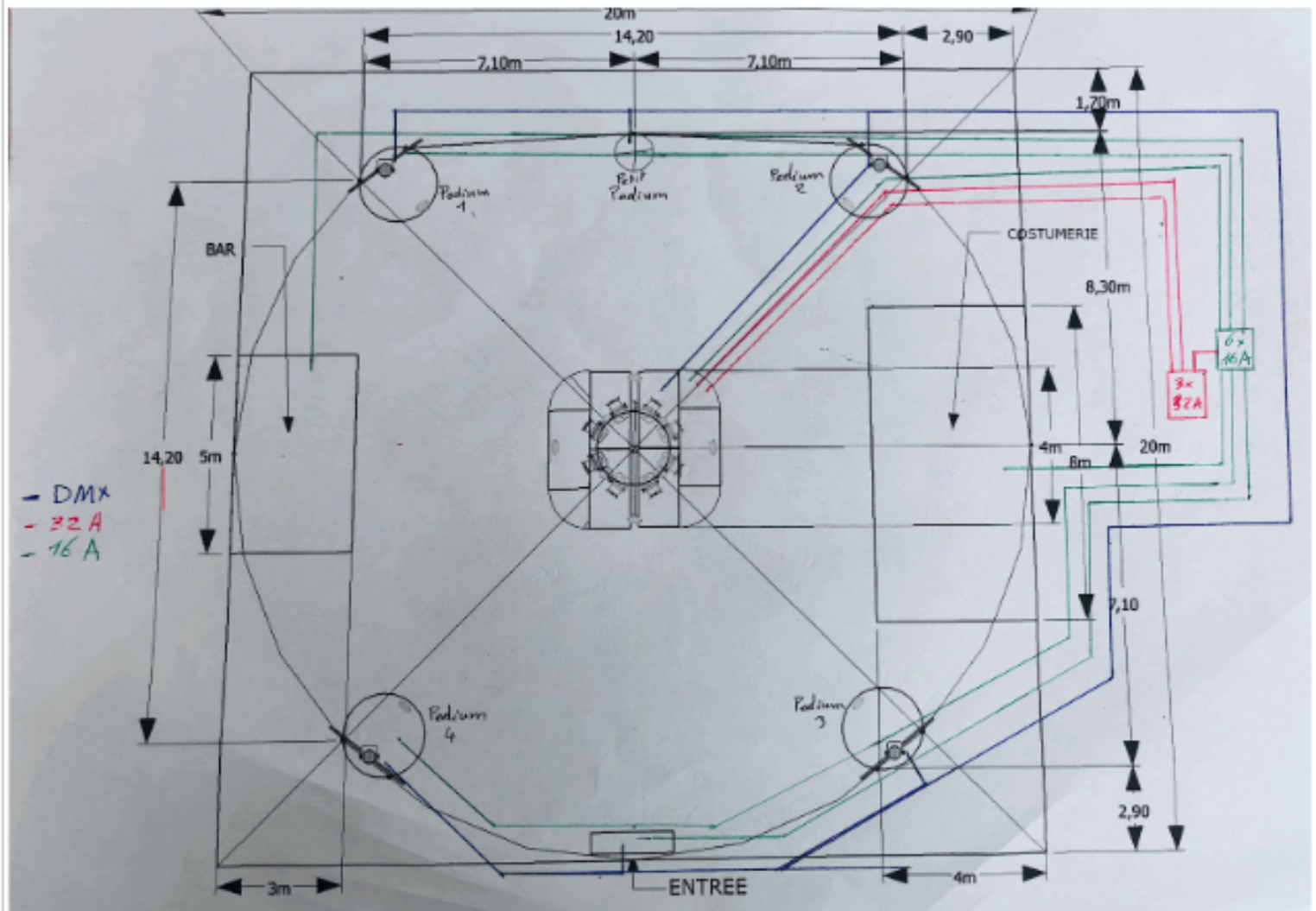

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SOUND ENGINEERING MATERIAL REQUEST

SOUND:

- 4 Loudspeaker 10' (such as [Q10 d&b audio](#)), with a base / maximum dimensions : 537x337x315
- 6 stage monitors 15' (such as [max15 db audio](#)).
- 2 stage monitors 12' – monitors for the musicians (such as [max15 db audio](#))

ALL OF THE LOUDSPEAKERS MUST BE FITTED FOR SLIP ON TUBES – NO STANDS NEEDED

- 5 subwoofers 18' (such as [Q-sub d&b audio](#)) (hight max : 60 cm)
- Amplifiers and dedicated processors.
- 1 mulipair 8 (minimum 15m) with male AND female splitter
- 1 mulipair 12 (minimum 15m) with male AND female splitter
- **1 live snake (male and female) multicore cable (15 m minimum)**

Each loudspeaker must have its own separate and independent power amplifier!!!!

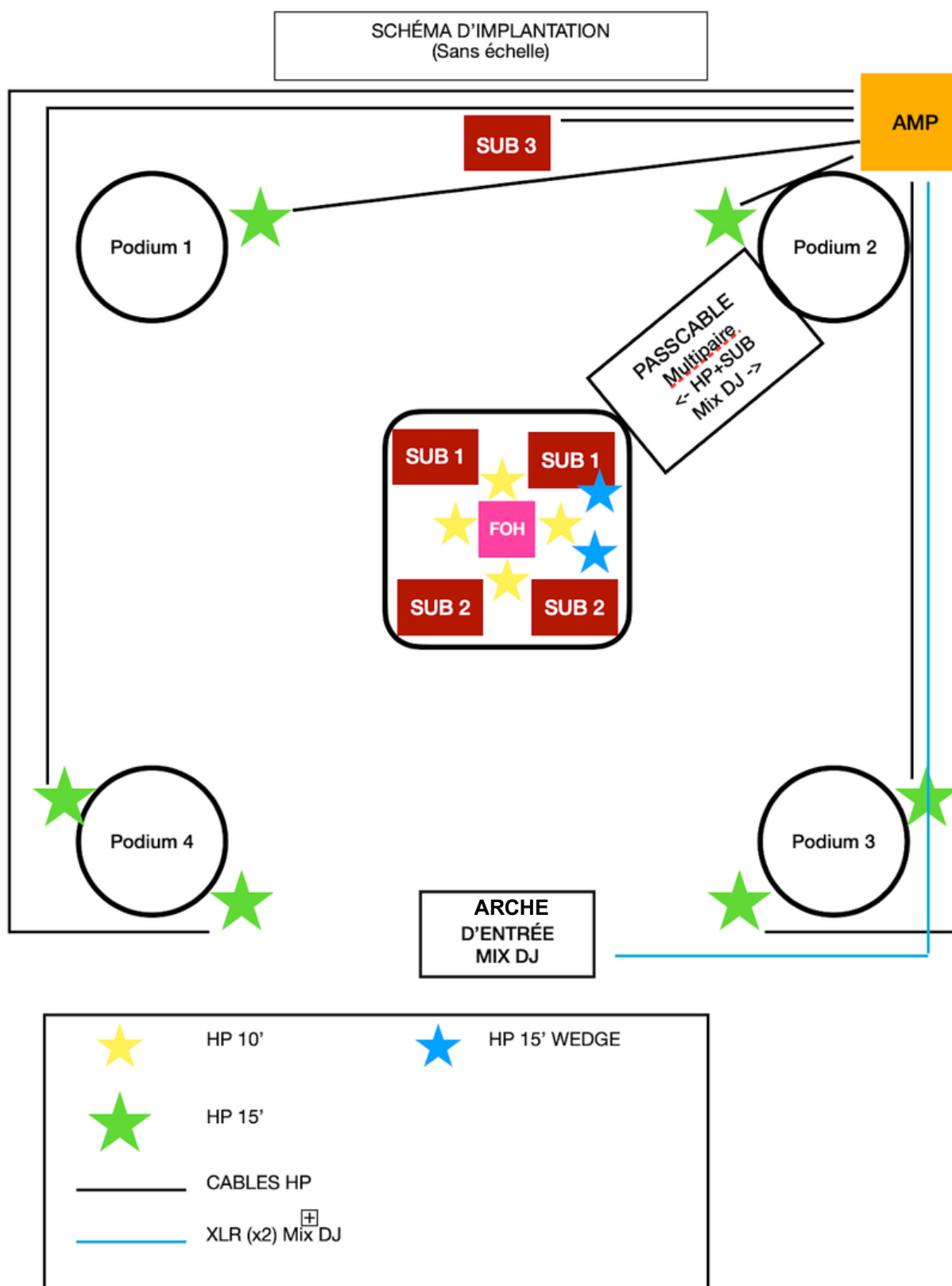

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Dressing room :

Close to the venue (easily and quickly accessible on foot), the artists will need a large, clean, heated dressing room that is out of sight and can be locked or guarded/monitored and equipped with a table and chairs, mirrors, racks with hangers, selective waste, electrical sockets and toilets nearby.

There should be showers and towels provided for the artists after the performance.

Costumes:

For team costumes, please arrange for one cleaning service per performance.

Catering :

Please provide a water point for filling water bottles, snacks with small cakes and honey, fruit, cold drinks (fruit juices, soft drinks, local craft beers if possible) and hot drinks.

Hot drinks – 100% Arabica coffee (no red coffee). If possible, please prefer fair-trade and organic coffee and tea.

Meal :

If the meals are included in the contract, please provide 12 to 13 hot meals in the dressing rooms 2 hours before the show, with a balanced diet that respects our dietary requirements.

Please provide a microwave to heat them up.

Accommodation:

If accommodation is provided for in the contract, please book 13 single rooms. No twin rooms. Depending on the availability of accommodation in the surrounding area, the team may accept to stay in a guest house.

The accommodation must **be close to the venue** (accessible in less than 10 minutes by foot). The vehicles are to remain on the guarded site, so bikes (better) or transportation will be needed if the accommodation is further away.

We don't ask for more than what we need to make sure we have enough.

We can always adapt to specific conditions, but all we ask is

to be informed in advance so that we can work out solutions together. Thank you for never presenting us with a 'fait accompli' on the day of the show.
